

ORDINANCE 2007-03
AMENDMENT TO LEEDS LAND USE ORDINANCE 05-02

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY WITHIN THE TOWN OF LEEDS BY PROVIDING TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICIALS THE NAMES OF LONG TERM RESIDENTS WITHIN MOBIL HOME AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that in order to improve public safety that the names of all residents of Leeds including long term residents of mobile home and recreational parks be available in order for them to better perform their assigned services, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that the names and addresses of most residents are available through the trash billing process, the names of mobile home and recreational vehicle parks residents are not available, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council in order to rectify this oversight and improve public safety has determined that the names of long term residents in mobile home and recreational vehicle parks will be provided to the Leeds Town Clerk/Recorder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Leeds, Utah that the following paragraph be added:

11.6.1.1 Each mobile home park and recreational vehicle park owner or manager shall provide to the Leeds Town Clerk/Recorder a list of names of any residents and the space number they are occupying, within three (3) days of their registering, if those residents plan to stay or stay more than fifteen (15) days. In addition, a summary list of all residents who have been residents longer than fifteen (15) days shall be submitted to the Leeds Town Clerk/Recorder at the end of March, June, September and December of each year, and include the corresponding space number being occupied by each resident.
