

# TOWN OF LEEDS

## ORDINANCE 2009-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEEDS, UTAH ADOPTING THE ACCESS MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE MEMBERS OF THE TRANSPORTATION EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE EASTERN WASHINGTON COUNTY RURAL PLANNING ORGANIZATION AND INCORPORATING THE ACCESS MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT AS ADDENDUM #1 TO THE LEEDS MASTER ROAD PLAN (ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 2007-15).

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Leeds is a member of the Transportation Executive Council of the Eastern Washington County Rural Planning Organization (RPO); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Leeds participated in the negotiation and drafting of a cooperative agreement made by and between the members of the RPO regarding access management; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Leeds desires to adopt criteria regarding the granting of access along State highways and other roadways within the boundaries of the RPO; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Leeds desires the cooperation of the Utah Department of Transportation and neighboring jurisdictions and to reciprocate cooperation with neighboring jurisdictions in regional transportation planning; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leeds, State of Utah, as follows:

1. Agreement Approved. The Town of Leeds approves and enters into the Access Management Agreement made by and between the members of the Transportation Executive Council of the Eastern Washington County Rural Planning Organization and incorporates the Access Management Agreement as Addendum #1 to the Leeds Master Road Plan (established by Ordinance 2007-15).
2. Repealer. This Ordinance supersedes or repeals the provision(s) of any ordinance(s), resolution(s) or section(s) of the Leeds Town Ordinance that is (are) inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.
3. Saving Clause. If any provision or clause in this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or entity or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other sections, provisions, clauses, or applications hereof which can be implemented without the invalid provision(s), clause(s), or


application(s) hereof, and to this end the provisions and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2009.
