

**TOWN OF LEEDS
RESOLUTION 2010-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LEEDS TOWN COUNCIL TO CREATE AND EMPOWER A
TOWN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Town of Leeds, to prepare for the potential of a major emergency or disaster, so as to save lives, prevent injury, protect property and preserve the environment, to the maximum extent possible with existing resources and under existing conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Leeds recognizes the need to prepare for emergencies and disasters of many different types and causes; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Leeds supports the principle of emergency and disaster preparedness for the community, its businesses, families and citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Leeds desires to prepare for the potential of a major emergency or disaster collaboratively with the Leeds Area Special Service District, Leeds Domestic Waterusers Association and other local service providers; and


WHEREAS, the joint participation of local residents together with municipal and service provider authorities can augment the limited resources of Town staff in preparing for the potential of a major emergency or disaster; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Leeds, Utah, as follows:

1. The Town of Leeds hereby establishes the Town of Leeds Emergency Preparedness Committee (“Emergency Committee”) for the purpose of preparing for the potential of a major emergency or disaster, so as to save lives, prevent injury, protect property and preserve the environment, to the maximum extent possible with existing resources and under existing conditions.
2. The Committee shall be comprised of the following members or their assignee:
 - a. Town of Leeds Mayor or assigned Town Council Member
 - b. Town of Leeds Chief of Police
 - c. LASSD Fire Chief
 - d. Member of the LDWA Board of Directors
 - e. Representative(s) of Faith Based Organizations
 - f. Representatives of Utility Providers, as applicable
 - g. Representative of Town Staff, as needed
 - h. At least one (but no more than four) Leeds Area resident(s)
3. The Committee shall meet at least monthly and make reports to the Town Council at least once per calendar quarter.


4. The Committee shall have the responsibility of drafting and recommending to the Leeds Town Council a Town of Leeds Emergency Plan ("Emergency Plan") by no later than February 2011. Thereafter, under the direction of the Leeds Town Council, the Committee shall have the responsibility of implementing the Emergency Plan.
5. The Committee may not expend any Town Funds, except those authorized by an approved Town budget.
