

Road Accessibility
during
Mine Tailings Clean-Up Project

1. The location of the tailings 'cap-in-place' will be at the toe of the slope beneath the road that traverses the White Reef. This road will not be compromised or closed during the project.
2. The lower road which is located immediately adjacent to the tailings pile may have limited access due to the very close proximity of the pile but it will not be entirely closed during the project. Folks will still be able to drive-by. The workers may put traffic cones up depending upon the need.
3. A culvert is being built across this lower road for drainage, so at some time the access on the lower road may be limited but not closed off.
4. The access road coming from Silver Reef will likely be improved to get the earth-moving vehicles to the site. In no case its condition be worse than when the project started.
5. The people doing the work are employees of the Bureau of Reclamation (out of the Provo office).
