

Some contact information to change your address

- Department of Motor Vehicle Division: can be done on line, no charge.
(dmv.utah.gov/addresschange.html)
- Department of Drivers Licensing: can be done online, no charge unless you go to them and want it changed on your physical driver's license card. (\$18.00) (not required.)
(publicsafety.utah.gov/dld/)
- Utility Companies: They provide a place to make changes on their bills
- Banks and Credit Unions: Have your account information available, can be done on line at no charge. This includes personal, business, CD's, Bonds
- Utah State Bar: Rule 14-507 requires you to maintain your current physical address with the Utah Bar, there online site is: No cost mentioned.

- Those who report to the Utah Department of Corrections including Sex Offenders:

- Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing (DOPL) No fee to go on line and change your address. A \$10.00 fee is charged to have a new copy of the license printed. (State of Utah) (www.dopl.utah.gov/)
